



Peter Hemingway Fitness and Leisure Centre (formerly Coronation Pool) 13808 – 111 Avenue, Edmonton, Alberta

Designed in 1967 as a Canadian Centennial project and opened in 1970, the Peter Hemingway Fitness and Leisure Centre (formerly called Coronation Pool) is one of Edmonton's most iconic buildings. The

architect Peter Hemingway received the highest honour in Canadian architecture, the Massey Medal for the design in 1970; he was the first Albertan to receive this prestigious award. Built of wood, concrete, steel, cables and glass, its distinctive rolling cresting wave design resembles the Alberta mountains and prairies. This unique swimming facility transformed the ordinary into a vibrant and active community space that continues to draw in the people of Edmonton and beyond.
