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




Local specialities of exceptional quality

The Home Gardens project



Funded by the FFEM (French Fund for Global Environment), this project running by Federal Ethiopian Environmental Authority is a Franco-Ethiopian Project linking institutions of the North and the South.

The project is organized around three objectives:

- 1. The **identification** and description of Ethiopian specialties produced in Home Gardens
- 2. The set up and implementation of a legal and institutional system of protection of Geographical Indications (design of origin and/or trademark)
- 3. The creation of a House of Gardens It's a resource center which facilitate information exchange on the Ethiopian gardens and a museum to celebrate the natural diversity of gardens of Ethiopia and the know-how of the farmers, a shop, tasting place.

Restore and design the museum:


- Local organic materials coming from home gardens




